Dear Students,

The third dose of the Trumenba vaccine to protect against the Serogroup B strain of meningitis will be offered to the Class of 2019 on **Sunday, March 20, 2016 from 2:00pm – 5:00pm in Peterson**. The appointment schedule (by residence hall) is below.

- Anyone who received the first or second dose of the vaccine is eligible. Additionally, any student who did not receive the first or second dose, but would like to begin now, is also welcome to attend.
- There is no cost to any student who wishes to be vaccinated and no proof-of-insurance is necessary.

Students should be aware that completion of the three dose series is important for achieving immunity.
