The second dose of the vaccine to protect against the Group B strain of meningitis will be offered on **Sunday April 12**, 2015 from 9am-6pm in Peterson. Anyone who received the first vaccine is eligible.

A much smaller clinic will be held (only for those students who will not be on campus on the 12th) on Wednesday April 15, 2015 from 10am-5pm.

In the meantime, please remember that our community is still at risk and we need to follow the Stop the Swap guidelines:

This bacterial infection is spread through direct secretions from the nose or mouth through activities such as kissing; or sharing food, drinks, water bottles, toothbrushes, eating utensils, smoking materials, cosmetics, and lip balms.

A person can be a carrier of meningitis without any symptoms.

While this is not an exhaustive list, the following precautions are recommended by the Department of Health:

Please don't share food, drinks, smoking materials, eating utensils, cosmetics or lip balm
Always cough into a sleeve or tissue
Wash your hands frequently
Use hand sanitizer often
Don't drink from a common source such as a punch bowl
