Dear Students,

For any student who has not received either the first, second, or third dose of the **meningitis vaccine** to protect against the Serogroup B strain, an on-campus clinic will be taking place on **Saturday, November 7, 2015 from 1:00pm – 4:00pm in Peterson.**

- Any member of the classes of 2016, 2017, or 2018 is welcome to attend at any time.
- There is no cost to any student who wishes to be vaccinated and no proof-of-insurance is necessary.
- Students who have recently received, or would like to receive, a flu shot should not be concerned about also receiving the meningitis vaccination. Per the RI Department of Health, there is no risk to receiving both the meningitis vaccine and the flu vaccine at the same time or in close proximity.
